**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROVING AN ACQUISITION FROM
POLK COUNTY OF A PERMANENT EASEMENT FOR MULTI-USE TRAIL TO
FACILITATE A TRAIL CONNECTION TO THE GAY LEA WILSON TRAIL NEAR
CARNEY MARSH**

WHEREAS, the City of Ankeny recently paved the former granular trail connection that runs between the Gay Lea Wilson Trail and the neighborhood trail on SE Primrose Drive within the Cassidy Heights Plat 1 subdivision which is located just to the north of Carney Marsh; and

WHEREAS, with the new permanent surfacing in place, Polk County deemed it appropriate that a permanent easement be issued to the City of Ankeny to memorialize the trail connection to the Gay Lea Wilson Regional Trail; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ankeny, Iowa, deems it to be in the best interest of the City to acquire the permanent easement for multi-use trail from Polk County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Ankeny, Iowa, that the attached permanent easement for multi-use trail is hereby accepted and approved, and staff is hereby directed to do all things necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
