

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROVING A QUIT CLAIM DEED TO FACILITATE THE TRANSFER OF ABANDONED ROADWAY RIGHT-OF-WAY KNOWN AS COUNTY NE 62ND AVENUE FROM POLK COUNTY TO THE CITY OF ANKENY

WHEREAS, as part of the Iowa Department of Transportation's 2004 Interstate 35 Reconstruction project, the portion of County NE 62nd Avenue between Interstate 35 and the Union Pacific Railroad R/W in Section 6 and 7, T-79-N, R-23-W was abandoned; and

WHEREAS, this portion of abandoned roadway in the name of Polk County is within the corporate limits of the City of Ankeny; and

WHEREAS, Polk County has no use or interest in the said abandoned roadway; and

WHEREAS; the City of Ankeny is contemplanting utilizing the far west portion of the said abandoned roadway as a location for a city welcome / gateway sign; and

WHEREAS, the Polk County Board of Supervisors approved the transfer and conveyance of interest in the said abandoned roadway to the City of Ankeny by Resolution No. 124-16 on August 16, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Ankeny, Iowa, that the attached quit claim deed is hereby accepted and approved and staff is hereby directed to do all things necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
